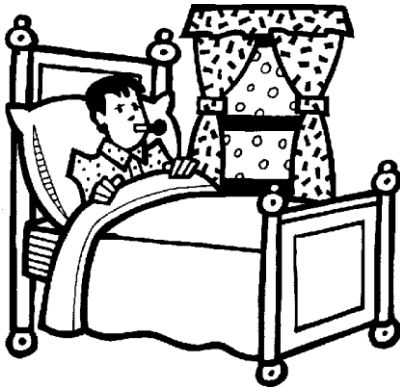
HEALTH ISSUES IN OUR COMMUNITY VOCABULARY
