tradition: a way of doing something that has been part of a culture for a long time.



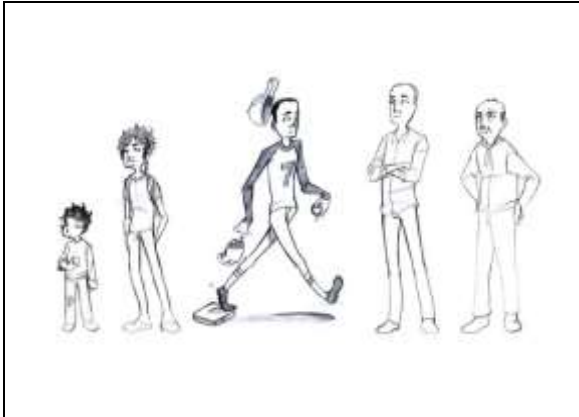
Preserve: to keep or protect something



Garment factory: a place where clothing is made...



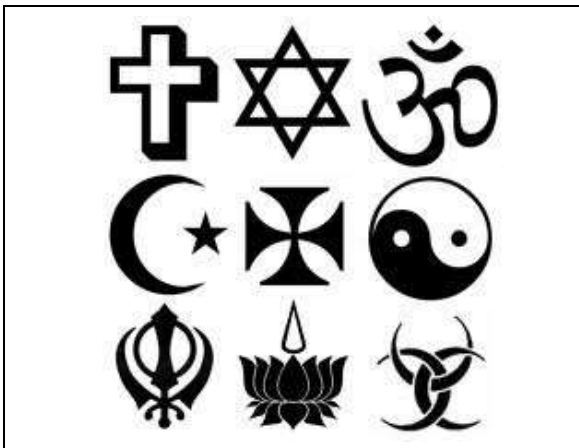
Spouse: someone who is married; a husband or wife.



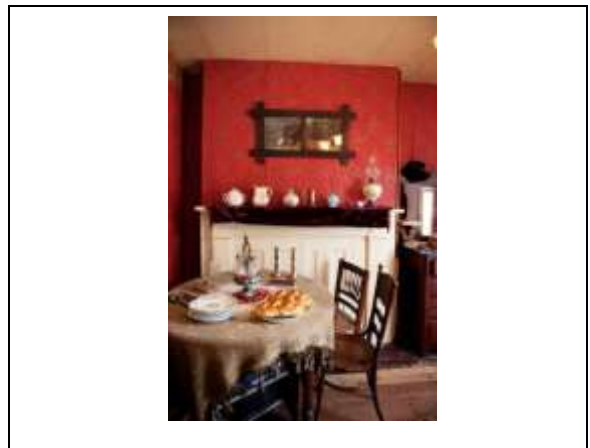
teenager: people between the ages of 13 and 18 years old.



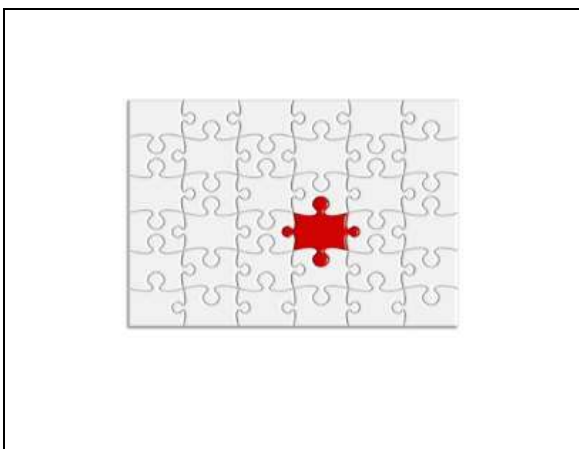
Observant: people who follow a religion closely.
